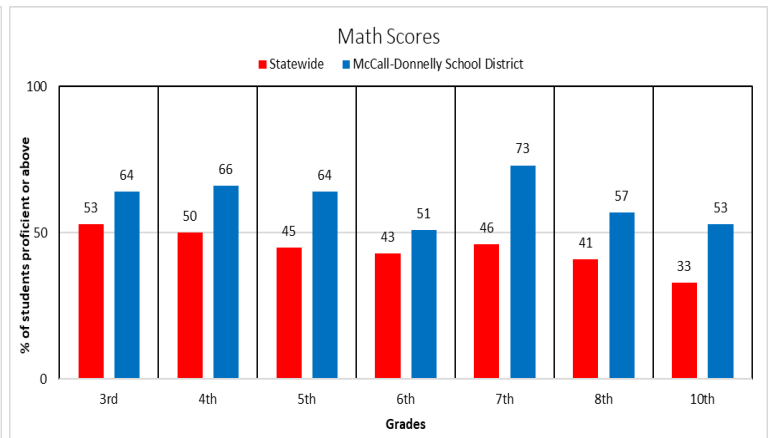
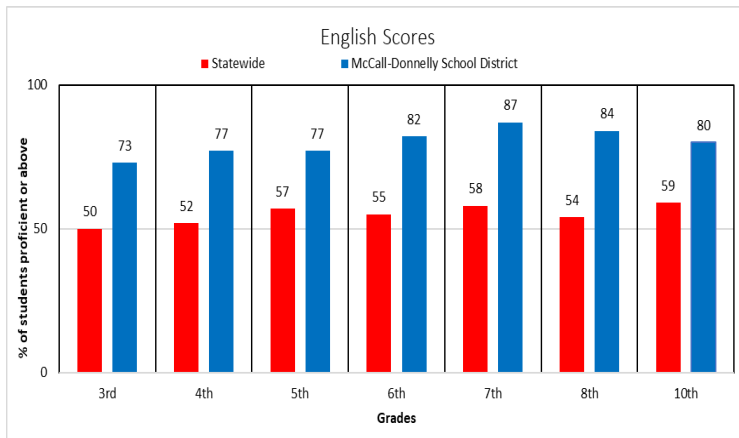
The Assessment Department contributes to the mission of the School District:

- ◆ By coordinating state and federally mandated assessments and facilitating support for individual needs of teachers and students.
- ◆ By ensuring compliance by staff and students of testing regulations.
- ◆ By providing training to proctors and staff in test administration.
- ◆ By providing testing data to administrators, teachers, and parents.
- ◆ By distributing information from the State Department of Education to administrators and teachers.

Common Core State Standards and Smarter Balanced Assessment

- ◆ In 2009, Idaho adopted the Common Core State Standards (CCSS), which provide a consistent, clear understanding of what students are expected to learn in English language arts and mathematics. The Smarter Balanced Assessment measures students ability to think critically and apply knowledge
- ◆ For the 2019-2020 school year Idaho is continuing with the Smarter Balanced Assessment as it is aligned to the Common Core. The assessment will gauge how well students are mastering the standards and ultimately how ready they are for college and further career readiness. This test will take place in the spring of 2020.
- ◆ The McCall—Donnelly School District prides itself in the ability to prepare our students for the world of work and life in the future. This can be evidenced by student test scores across the district. With the support of the community, our teachers, and the commitment of our students we consistently score higher than most other schools around the state.
