

The McCall-Donnelly School District proposes a meal price increase for the 2018–19 school year. The district participates in the federally funded National School Lunch Program, which requires school districts to raise prices to help close the gap between the price of paid meals and the amount the federal government reimburses for free meals. The price increases will have no effect on students who qualify for free and reduced federal program. Lunch meal prices will not be affected. The current price for student breakfast is \$1.00. The proposed price for student breakfast is \$1.50, for school year 2018-2019.
