
The McCall-Donnelly School District is committed to our mission statement of ***"Developing Life-Long Learners, Today!"*** In that commitment, and amid the global COVID19 pandemic, we recognize that for many students there is no replacement to the live classroom Environment. We are prepared to offer a live classroom experience for students, to the greatest extent possible. The safety of your student(s) and our staff is the most important factor. To that end, we have developed in-person solutions that are responsive to local conditions. Local conditions are defined by levels of community spread of the COVID-19 respiratory illness, as follows:

Stage 1 or "Green"

We can provide education for all students in school, every day. Additional safety measures will be in place, consistent with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), as well as local ordinances and directives. Currently, Central District Health has instituted a mandatory mask / face covering ordinance, which applies to all schools.

Stage 2 or "Yellow"

We can provide education for all students in school, 50% of the time. The McCall-Donnelly School District Pandemic Operational Summary Plan calls for a rotation in which half of the students attend physical school on Monday and Wednesday, and every other Friday. The other half of the students attend on Tuesday and Thursday, and the opposite Friday. In this stage, students engage in independent learning (asynchronous) on the days in which they are not in school. This may require support from the family, especially for elementary age children. Additional safety measures will be in place, consistent with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), as well as local ordinances and directives. Currently, Central District Health has instituted a mandatory mask / face covering ordinance, which applies to all schools.

Stage 3 or "Red"

In this stage, all learning is delivered remotely, and students are not physically in the building. It is important to note that classrooms, schools, or the district may be required to work remotely for short periods of time throughout the year.

Barbara Morgan and Donnelly Elementary (In-Person) Stage 2

You can anticipate a combination of live scheduled instruction (synchronous) and independent learning (asynchronous). Live instruction will be delivered either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, as well as every other Friday. An emphasis will be placed on core instruction. Extensive safety measures are in place. (See McCall-Donnelly Pandemic Operational Plans.) Physical distancing will be maintained. Masks / face coverings are required, consistent with CDC guidelines and directives from CDH.

Payette Lakes Middle School (In-Person) Stage 2

Students will be enrolled in five classes: 4 Core classes and 1 elective. Live instruction will be delivered either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, as well as every other Friday. Students will have a designated advisor for advisory time. Students will have independent learning (asynchronous) expectations when they are not scheduled for in-person instruction. Extensive safety measures are in place. (See McCall-Donnelly Pandemic Operational Plans.) Physical distancing will be maintained. Masks / face coverings are required, consistent with CDC guidelines and directives from CDH.

McCall-Donnelly High School (In-Person) Stage 2

You can anticipate a combination of live scheduled instruction (synchronous) and independent learning (asynchronous). Live instruction will be delivered either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, as well as every other Friday. The traditional block schedule in which students attend four classes daily for 90 minutes each will be delivered in eight classes daily, for 50 minutes each. There is an expectation that students engage in independent learning on the days in which they are not participating in live instruction. Extensive safety measures are in place. (See McCall-Donnelly Pandemic Operational Plans.) Physical distancing will be maintained. Masks / face coverings are required, consistent with CDC guidelines and directives from CDH.

Heartland High School (In-Person) Stage 2

You can anticipate a combination of live scheduled instruction (synchronous) and independent learning (asynchronous). Live instruction will be delivered either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, as well as every other Friday. If physical distancing can be maintained, additional days of instruction will be available. There is an expectation that students engage in independent learning on the days in which they are not participating in live instruction. Extensive safety measures are in place. (See McCall-Donnelly Pandemic Operational Plans.) Physical distancing will be maintained. Masks / face coverings are required, consistent with CDC guidelines and directives from CDH.
