Instruction

Student Information Management System

Purpose:

This policy provides direction for establishment, operation and maintenance of a district-wide education information management system.

Board of Trustees – The Board will oversee the establishment and ongoing operation and maintenance of a district-wide student information management system implementation. The Board may utilize data from the system to inform governance decisions and to create and implement effective policy leading to efficiencies in the delivery of educational services as well as increasing student achievement.

Administration – District administration will implement, operate and maintain the management system district-wide as directed by the Board of Trustees. Moreover, administration may utilize data from the system to aid in the creation of greater effectiveness and efficiencies in the management of district resources with a focus on student achievement.

Instructional – Instructional staff will utilize the system to aid as needed to process student data and to inform instruction with the goal of increased student achievement.

Non-instruction – Non-instructional staff may utilize the system to aid in the management of the day-to-day operations of the district's educational system.

Parent/Guardian – Parents or legal guardians may be provided access to the system's portal of communicating with the school administration and instructional staff. The portal can provide a conduit for real-time information and data on their student's progress.
