Students

Attendance

Parents or guardians are required to have children ages 7 through 16 enrolled in and attending a public, private, or parochial school. This school must meet the certification and standard requirements of the State of Idaho.

The Board of Trustees is responsible for the education of all school-aged children within District boundaries. Therefore, it reserves the right to insure comparability of services at all other schools.

The parent or guardian of any child who has reached the age of seven (7) years, but not the age of sixteen (16) years shall be instructed in subjects commonly and usually taught in the public schools. Unless the child is otherwise comparably instructed, the parent or guardian shall enroll the child in a public, private, or parochial school for a period each year equal to that during which the public schools are in session.

Whenever it is determined by the Board, or the Board's designee, under the provisions of due process of law that the education of any child not enrolled in the public schools is failing to meet the state standard requirements an authorized representative of the Board shall notify in writing the prosecuting attorney in the county of the pupil's residence and recommend that a petition shall be filed in the magistrates division of the District Court of the county of the pupil's residence, in such form as the court may require.
