

## Policy 3200

### Students

#### Student Rights and Responsibilities

All students between the ages of five (5) and twenty-one (21) have a basic right to attend school. This right is inherent; it is not a privilege granted to the students. It is recognized that a student's primary and fundamental purpose in attending school is to engage in learning and his or her cooperation and dedication is fundamental to quality education.

#### Rights

1. All students have an equal right to education opportunities.
2. All students are allowed their constitutionally protected rights of free speech, due process, petition and assembly, as long as they do not disrupt the educational process of the school or interfere with the property or constitutional rights of others.

#### Responsibilities

1. All students who attend the district's schools will comply with the written policies, rules and regulations of the schools, shall pursue the required course of studies, and shall submit to the authority of staff of the schools, subject to such corrective action as the school officials determine.

The administration shall develop and make available to all students, their parents and staff written statements pertaining to student rights, conduct or corrective actions. Such statements shall be developed with the participation of parents and the community. The school principal and staff shall confer at least annually to develop and/or review student conduct standards and the uniform enforcement of those standards.

Parents shall also be advised of their right to review classroom materials.
