Freedom of Assembly

Students are encouraged to participate in student government. The student government provides all students through a representative system a voice in school affairs. Registered students should be eligible to hold office if they meet the academic and citizenship qualifications of the individual school's constitution.

Individual students and student organizations may meet in school rooms or auditoriums, or at outdoor locations on school grounds, to discuss, pass resolutions and take other lawful action respecting any matter which directly or indirectly concerns or affects them, whether or not it relates to school. Such activities shall not be permitted to interfere with the educational process or normal operation of the school.

Peaceful demonstrations are permissible, though they are to be held in designated places where they shall present no hazards to persons or property and at designated times that shall not disrupt classes or other school activities.
