Students

Search of School Property Used by Students

General Inspection

School lockers, electronic devices, including computers and desks are school district property, and as such, are subject to periodic inspections without permission and without notice, by school administration or designees or by school administration or designees accompanied by police officers. No right or expectation of privacy exists for any student as to the use of any locker, electronic device, including computer or desk issued or assigned to a student by the school.

Targeted Search

Any school locker, electronic device, including computer, desk, or other storage assigned to a student shall be subject to search if reasonable grounds exist to suspect that the search will yield evidence of the student's violation of the law or school rules. Any search shall be conducted according to board policy governing personal searches. (See Policy 3355)

General Search with Reasonable Suspicion Related to a Personal Item

An all school search of school lockers, electronic devices, including computers, desks, or other storage assigned to a student may be conducted at any time without prior notice and without reasonable suspicion that the search will yield evidence of any particular student's violation of the law or school rules. If the school administration or designee conducting such a search develops a reasonable suspicion that any item inside the locker, including but not limited to a purse, electronic device, backpack, gym bag, or an article of clothing, contains evidence of a student's violation of the law or school rules, the item may be searched according to board policy governing personal searches.
