Emergency Drills

Students shall receive instruction so that in case of fire or sudden emergency they shall be able to leave their particular building in the shortest time possible, or take such other steps as the particular emergency demands, without confusion or panic. Exit drills shall be held regularly, not less than monthly during the school year, to assure rapid and orderly evacuation of the building. Drills for specific emergency conditions, are a part of the principal's responsibility.

Principals are directed to develop emergency evacuation procedures for each building in accordance with district guidelines.
