Students

Secondary Student Activities

Student activities programs are regarded by the board as a vital part of the total school program and are designed to afford students an opportunity to participate in a variety of activities, to develop skills and talents, and to develop leadership and wholesome attitudes.

The principal or designee shall be responsible for the organization of all student activities, shall provide for adequate supervision, oversee student finances, and approve all student activities that are sponsored by his/her school.

All students who participate in the extra-curricular activities programs of the McCall-Donnelly School District will meet the minimum requirements established by the Idaho State Activities Association plus any additional standards established by the school.

Principals or designees shall develop and approve a comprehensive set of standards that are designed to:

1. Define attendance requirements, at school and at practice.
2. Define training rules, including expected behaviors.
3. Define expectations for behavior and dress when representing the school.
4. Provide assurance of insurance coverage and physical examinations
5. Outline transportation policies governing student transportation to and from contests and practices.
6. Outline and define such other standards as may be appropriate.
7. Clearly state action(s) that will result from violations of those standards.
8. Outline standards governing the awarding of the school letter.

Those standards, the McCall-Donnelly School District Secondary Student Activities Code of Conduct, will be printed and distributed to students and parents who participate in student activities. Each head coach will hold a parent meeting within the first week of beginning practice to review and discuss standards with parents of participants.

All expenses of student activities programs except coaching salaries, transportation, catastrophic insurance and the provision and upkeep of physical plant facilities are paid from student funds or building discretionary funds.

Volunteer coaches and sponsors must be approved by the principal or designee and are subject to the same background checks as are employees of the district.

Transportation to and from contests will be on school district provided vehicles unless prior approval has been granted by administration. (see BP 3245)
