Holidays

The District shall observe the following holidays and shall not be opened for public purpose or operation on these days:

- New Years' Day (January 1)
- Human Rights Day (January 21)
- President's Day (third Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (last Monday in May)
- Independence Day (July 4)
- Labor Day (first Monday in September)
- Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November)
- The day after Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day (December 25)
- Whenever any legal holiday falls on Sunday the preceding Friday shall be a legal holiday.

In those cases where an employee, is required to work any of these holidays, another day shall be granted in lieu of such holiday unless the employee elects to be paid for the holiday in addition to the employee's regular rate of pay for all time worked on the holiday.

If a holiday occurs during the period in which vacation is being taken by an employee, the holiday shall not be charged against the employee's annual leave.
