

## Policy 8200

### Non Instructional Operations

#### Food Service

McCall-Donnelly School District shall provide wholesome and nutritious meals as defined by the National School Lunch and Breakfast programs. The board authorizes the business manager to administer the food service program, provided that any decision to enter into a contract with a private food service agency shall require the approval of the board.

It is the expectation of the school district that students prepay, or pay at the time of service, for school meals. Elementary students will be allowed a one week charge period and middle school and high school students will be allowed a one day charge period. When the charge period expires service will be denied.

The purpose of the policy is to allow a means by which a student, who occasionally forgets or loses his/her money, can be provided a meal. Charges will be allowed under the following guidelines:

- One breakfast and one lunch may be charged per day per student;
- Parents will be notified by phone or in writing of charges;
- Charges will not be allowed beyond one week, with the exception of circumstances approved by the Food Services Director; and
- Adults are discouraged from charging meals.

Employees who incur charges may have their pay garnished at the end of each pay period.
